- Assess the market, undertake market engagement and testing
- Linkage to objectives and contract subject matter
- Specification and tender documents are clear on the requirement and link to the question(s) posed



Award criterion option



- Proportionate requirement
- Objective evaluation methodology
- Appropriately experienced and qualified tender panel



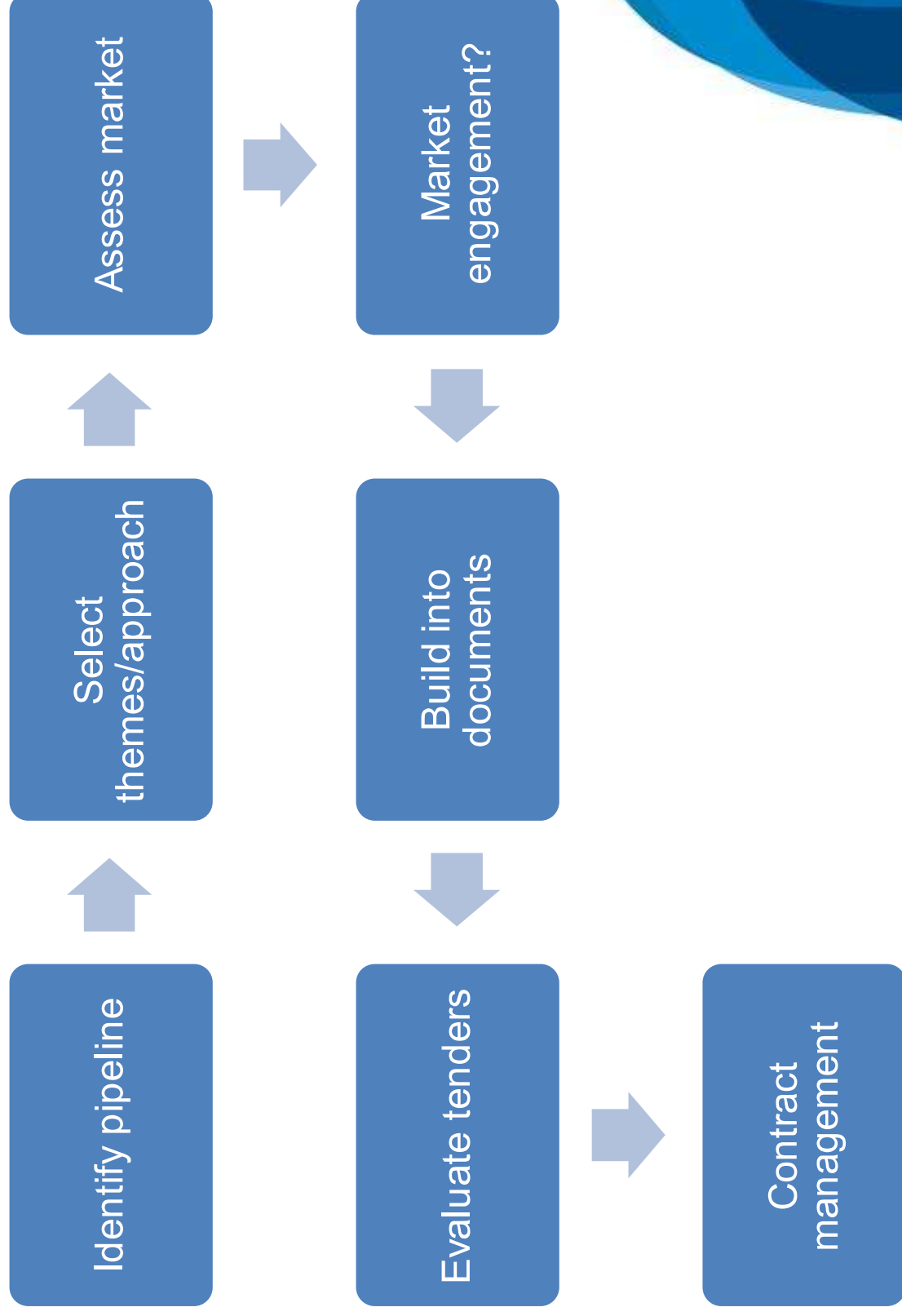
Don't forget the contract!

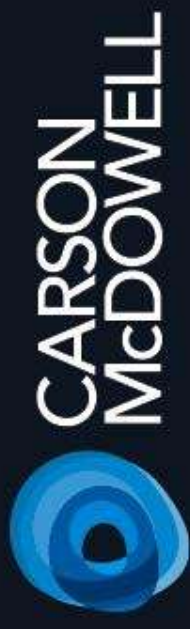


- Whatever approach you opt for, make sure that it's reflected in the contract!

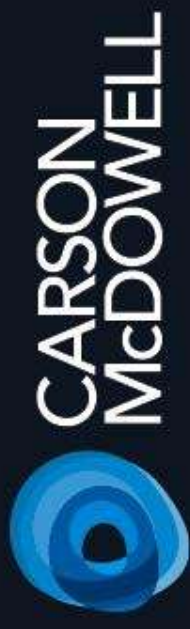
