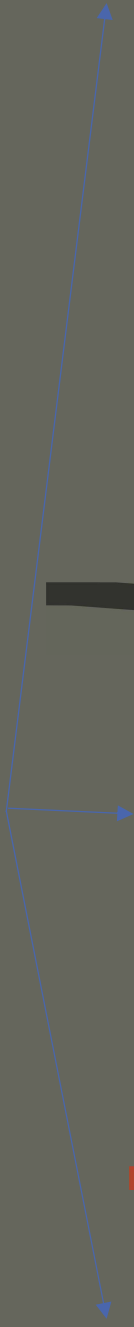

Public procurement evaluation blueprint

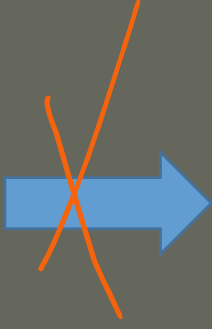
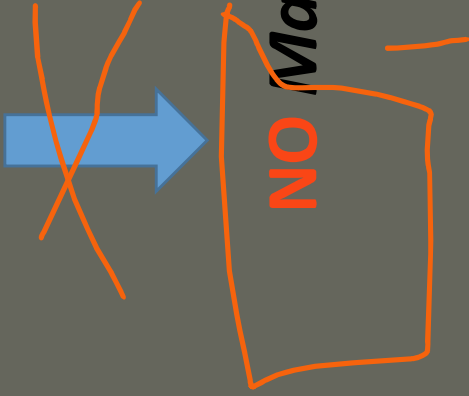

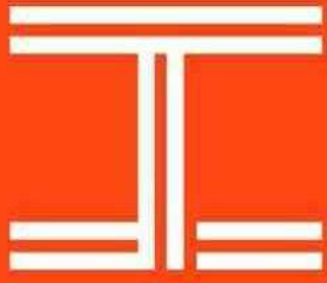


Margin of Appreciation
